

Erasmus+ and other international activities ss 2022

February 2022

The department did welcome two professors (Prof K. Metadel, Prof Seifu Tilahun) from the Bahir Dar university of Ethiopia, in the context of the ICM ERASMUS Programm. Based on the signed Inter Institutional agreement (IAA 2020-2023), Erasmus staff and PhD candidate mobility details were agreed and the upcoming visit's planned. Both universities, namely BDU and UniWA, submitted joined proposal with approx. 25 partners in the framework of the HorizonEU call

March 2022:

The departmental academic coordinator met colleagues at the Beykoz and Yeditepe Universities in Istanbul. Upon discussions bilateral agreements will be signed for students and staff mobilities in the context of the Erasmus+ Programm. In addition a joint proposal (PRIMA call) was discussed and submitted in collaboration with the food engineering (Prof Ozge TAŞTAN) department of the Yeditepe University. April 2022

The representative of the international office of the Odise University Belgium (Prof Steven MEEUS) visited the FES department (13-15 of April 2022). Common fields of scientific interest were discussed and the study plans equalities identified. Conclusively a collaboration with the Agro- and biotechnology department was agreed to be signed under the Erasmus+ framework.

April 2022

Two colleagues from Poland (Jagoda Zurek & Renata Stanistawczyk, Department of Agricultural Processing and Commodity Science , Institute of Food and Nutrition Technology, College of Natural Sciences, University of Rzeszów) visited the FES Dept in the context of an Erasmus training mobility. A departmental and laboratories guided tour gave them the opportunity to explore the educational and research activities of the dept.

April 2022

April 2022

SUSTAINABLE ENVIRONMENTAL DEVELOPMENT: INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGIES), meeting food science Dept's staff, presenting UniWA Food science and technology Dept, discussing Erasmus issues, meeting outgoing Erasmus student Th. Konstandinidi. New potential partners were identified (Romania - Sibiu Lucian Blaga University, Slovakia - Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava) and discussions will continue remotely towards a bilateral agreement. May 2022

Incoming Professor (Viktoria Szuts) from the partner Szeged University Hungary, gave lessons (rice properties) in the context of her teaching Erasmus mobility (2-6 of May 2022). It was a good opportunity to guide her in the department labs and university library. Discussion with staff in the field of molecular biology took place for possible future collaborations.

June 2022

A delegation of UniWA staff visited (June 13-17, 2022) the INTEC University, Republique of Saint Dominique, Carebean. The academic Erasmus supervisor of the food Dept gave lesson in relevant fields and departments (areas) in the frame of the ICM Erasmus staff teaching mobility. She also attended an „international Erasmus week“ in the context of the training part of the mixed mobility. Discussion on potential future Collaboration with colleagues from Istanbul and Krakow universities took also place.

June 2022
